

**Information från “UK International Liaison / Maritime & Coastguard Agency” (UK MCA) om trafiken mellan Danmark och UK**

- UK residents that have travelled from, or through, Denmark in the preceding 14 days are allowed to return to the UK where they must then travel to their home address and self-isolate for 14 days with their family (that includes seafarers and hauliers)
- Non-UK residents that have travelled from, or through, Denmark in the preceding 14 days will be denied entry to the UK – there are no exemptions
- Direct passenger carrying and accompanied freight services from Denmark to the UK are also not allowed to arrive into the UK; although SOLAS rules still apply
- Unaccompanied freight and cargo vessels that have entered a Danish port in the preceding 14 days are still allowed to arrive and unload in the UK.
  - however, all crew must not enter the UK nor have any meaningful interaction with any UK residents or port staff
  - UK pilotage will still be provided using the existing PPE and COVID secure measures
  - so basically crew should not disembark in UK unless it is for pre-departure safety (like checking draught before sailing)
