SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF THE IMPOSITION OF TRAVEL
RESTRICTIONS ON TRAVELERS FROM INDIA, PAKISTAN,
NEPAL, SRI LANKA, BANGLADESH, OMAN, AND THE
UNITED ARAB EMIRATES TO PREVENT THE ENTRY OF THE
SARS-COV-2 B.1.617 VARIANT FIRST DETECTED IN INDIA

DATE : 31 May 2021

Please be informed that the President has **approved** the recommendation of the IATF in its Resolution No. 117-B (s. 2021) to extend the travel restrictions on all travelers from India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Oman and the United Arab Emirates until 2359 H of 15 June 2021.

The IATF is hereby authorized to approve succeeding extensions of the duration of such travel restrictions, as may be necessary to prevent the further spread of the SARS-COV 2 B.1.617 variant in the country. However, the subject restrictions shall not be implemented with respect to any other country of origin unless approved by this Office.
